FIELD TRIP FAQ

How much does it cost to visit Westobou Gallery? Westobou Gallery is free and open to the public.

What are the Gallery hours?

Westobou Gallery is open from 10 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday through Friday. We are happy to make an appointment for another time with advance notice.

How many students and adult chaperones do I need for a field trip?

We appreciate when you are able to provide one chaperone per 10 students. We do not have a minimum group size for field trips. However, we can only serve up to 40 people at one time depending on capacity during the current exhibition. Larger groups would need to be divided.

Does my group have to arrive together?

The Gallery can typically accommodate groups up to 40 people. However, we think it is best to serve smaller groups. We are happy to provide multiple opportunities in one day to meet your needs. Check space capacity in advance as artwork can alter this.

Do you have eating facilities? We do not.

Can we eat lunch in the Gallery?

If space permits, we will allow eating. We don't regularly have seating. So, if you'd like to have tables and chairs please coordinate that with us in advance.

Do you have a place for us to store lunches?

We have a small conference room where lunches can be stored until they are to be delivered. However, we do not have refrigeration large enough to keep the meals cold.

How many adult chaperones do you require? We appreciate when you are able to provide one chaperone per 10 students.

Where do I/we check in? You can check in at the Gallery, 1129 Broad Street, downtown Augusta.
